

Our Lady 'Food Bank'

As you know, the school often supports the New Life Church Food Bank. However, in order to be able to use this valuable service, a referral and proof of income are required. I am conscious that there may be families in our school who do not meet the 'threshold' for income support and may earn just over the government's cut off limit. Therefore, in these times, when a lot of families are facing increased fuel costs, gas and electric costs and food prices etc, I would like to set up our own 'food bank'. As part of the school's Missionary Discipleship, I would like to reach out to families to support people in our own school community. If you are able to support this worthwhile cause, adding a couple of extra items to your weekly shop, please could I ask that you donate any dry goods, such as pasta, rice, tins, sauces (Ragu, Dolmio etc), shower gel, shampoo, sanitary products etc. and send them to the office.

If you do need to use the 'food bank', please contact me and we can arrange a suitable time for you to come into school and take items which are needed. All I ask is that you only take what you need and, when you are able to, return this act of kindness by donating to the food bank to support others in a similar situation. Items will be available for collection from Wednesday, 4th May 2022. The 'Little Act of Kindness Fund', through the St Therese of Lisieux Academy Trust, have kindly donated some money to start our food bank off. Feast of the Ascension
