Dear Parents and Carers



Uniform - September

Please ensure your child/ren are wearing the correct uniform when they return after the summer break. Please could you ensure that your children are wearing correct school shoes - NOT TRAINERS.

Preparation for September

As the children prepare to finish for the Summer break, please could I ask all parents to support their children throughout the summer to practise some basic skills so that they are ready to come back to school. Please could I ask that children can:

- get dressed and undressed independently
- fasten shoe laces especially if they are wearing lace-up school shoes
- tie their school tie correctly
- · tell the time using an analogue clock NOT digital time

PE Kits for September

EYFS and KS1 - If your child is in EYFS or KS1, we would like you to send in their PE kit at the start of the term, in their PE bags. Their kit will be kept in school until the end of each term. Throughout COVID, the children have mostly lost the ability to dress independently and many are requiring support. In order to address this problem, children should arrive to school in their uniform EVERY day. On the days when they have PE, they will practise the skills of getting changed/unchanged, as part of their learning journey, as we feel this is a vital part of their development.

KS2 - If your child is in KS2, we would like them to continue wearing their PE kits to school on the days they have PE. We have limited storage space in the classrooms and lack of space for the children to get changed separately, to protect their dignity.

Weekly Attendance

Well done everyone for a fantastic penultimate week of the term! It is brilliant to see a huge improvement in attendance! Let's keep this up for September.

As the new academic year starts, there will be a big focus on attendance. Look out for information at the start of Term 1 for the new rewards that will be put in place for those children who have an attendance figure of 96% or higher each term.

Please note that no holidays will be authorised and it will be listed as unauthorised absence. Please do not book any holidays during term time as this has a huge impact on your child's learning potential.
