Statement to Live By

This week's Statement to Live By is 'I understand rights match responsibility' as part of helping the children to 'know, appreciate and understand the importance of social justice and develop independence, interdependence and responsibility'.

The United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child is a legally-binding international agreement setting out the civil, political, economic, social and cultural rights of every child, regardless of their race, religion or abilities. Under Article 28 everyone at school has the right to learn, be safe and be happy. However, each person has a responsibility to make sure that they are not behaving in a way that disrespects the human rights of others. Rights and responsibilities come hand in hand.

Over the past few weeks, we have been speaking to the children about their right to be safe in school and that they have the right to learn through high expectations of behaviour. Each of the classes, using the School Mission Statement as guidance, have created a class charter where the children have agreed to be responsible for their behaviour towards others in class.

To support the children's understanding of rights and responsibilities, please discuss this further with them.
