Statement to Live By

This week's Statement to Live By is 'I try to stand up for myself and others without hurting others' as part of helping the children to 'know, appreciate and understand the importance of social justice and develop independence, interdependence and responsibility'.

As part of the school's ongoing anti-bullying work, the children have been learning that if someone is being unkind or unfair to them that in the first instance they ask that person to stop. If the behaviour continues, the children are taught to try to stand up for themselves or to stand up for someone who isn't able to. Being able to stand up for yourself, or others, takes courage and confidence as nobody likes confrontation.

However, it is important that when the children are standing up for themselves or others, they do it in a way that is respectful. A letter from St Paul demonstrates this:

"My brothers and sisters, if someone is caught doing something wrong, those of you who know better should set them right. But you must do it in a gentle way. And keep an eye on yourselves, so that you will not be tempted, too. Help to carry one another's burdens, and in this way you will obey the law of Jesus."

Weekly Attendance



A Date with Dan is a free TEAMS Online Safety Q and A for Parents and Guardians on the 7th December, 6-7pm. This is being hosted by the Lincolnshire Stay Safe Partnership to up level parents' knowledge and understanding of their children's online activities and to protect them from online harm.

Information from the LSSP states - 'Over two thirds of students surveyed in the LSCP 2021 Keeping Safe Online Survey indicated that their parents didn't know everything about their online activities. The survey also showed when parents talked openly to their children about their activity online, those students were less likely to experience cyberbullying and more likely to access support.'
