Statement to Live By

This week's Statement to Live By is 'I try to use words that make the world a better place ' as part of helping the children to 'Know that everything has the capacity to reveal God's presence and in the light of this develop effective and satisfying relationships'.

As we all know, our choice of words can either have a positive or negative effect on people. In school, as part of our OLGC Rules, we teach the children to use 'caring lips'. This means that they speak to one another and to the wider school community in a positive, polite way. When the children do not use 'caring lips' and their words have a negative effect on others, they are reminded why they should use 'caring lips'. Using kind words goes a long way in making people feel good and everyone deserves to feel good.

This week, encourage your child to use kind words: using manners to say please and thank you; offer a compliment to someone; offer to help someone; be honest and truthful; before speaking, think about the feelings of other people. Encourage them to 'think' before they speak using the acronym shown here. Before you speak: THINK T = Is it True? I = Is it Helpful? I = Is it Inspiring? N = Is it Necessary? K = Is it Kind?

The next Little Church will take place on Sunday, 5th February. All children between 3 and 11 years are welcome!


Dates in 2023: 5th /19th February, -- 5th /19th March, -- 2nd /16th April.

Ash Wednesday Mass
