Statement to Live By

This week's Statement to Live By is 'I know we are happiest when we are united 'as part of helping the children to 'Experience a sense of belonging within a range of communities, including the local Eucharistic Community, and play an active role as members of society'.

Last week's Statement to Live By focussed on being part of a community. This week's focus is how we are united as part of that community. Being united also brings people together, offering a sense of belonging and helps to foster healthy relationships.

Following on from last week's Scripture from the Acts of the Apostles, the passage below demonstrates how the disciples lived together in unity.

Many people joined the community of the friends of Jesus. They lived every day as they were taught. They lived like members of one big family. They ate together, sharing bread and wine as Jesus had done at the last supper. They prayed together often. Everyone was amazed at the life they lived. The apostles did wonderful things among the people. The community of friends shared everything with one another. They sold everything they owned and shared out the money so that each person had what they needed.

Every day they went together to the temple. Every day they met in their houses to break bread together. They happily shared their food with each other, praising God with joy. People were very impressed with the way they lived. Day by day more people joined them. They were totally together as a group....everything was shared.

Think about the reading and ask your child/ren....What do you think about the Scripture? How do you know the community was united? Do you think they were happy? Why?
