Statement to Live By

This week's Statement to Live By is 'I try to forgive people when they hurt me' as part of helping the children to 'Experience a reconciling community'.

It can be hard to forgive others, especially when they hurt us or bother us again and again. Jesus said we must keep forgiving people no matter how many times they do wrong to us or hurt us. In this week's Scripture, Jesus tells Peter how many times we should forgive other people.

"Peter came to Jesus and said, "Lord, if another member of the church sins against me, how often should I forgive? As many as seven times?" Jesus said to him, "Not just seven times, but, I tell you, 77 times."

This week, if somebody does you wrong and they apologise, it is important to forgive them. By doing so, we too are showing God's mercy to them. We all make mistakes!

Virtue - Courage

As mentioned in last week's newsletter, this term's Virtue is 'Courage'.

In school this week, the children will be learning about the Value of Resilience. Having resilience enables children to face challenges, and having the courage to do so, making adaptations to become successful.



IAs part of the children's emotional well-being and supporting their mental health, developing resilience can help children through to their adult lives. They are able to face challenging situations and positively deal with stresses meaning there is less risk of suffering from anxiety and depression in later life.
