Sun Safety at School

As the weather warms up, it's important to help pupils stay safe in the sun while enjoying outdoor play and learning. Here are a few simple ways we can all support sun safety at school:

Apply Sunscreen

Please apply a long-lasting, high-factor sunscreen (SPF 30+) before school.

Wear a Hat

A wide-brimmed hat offers great protection for the face, neck, and ears. Please send your child to school with a sun-safe hat each day.

Cover Up

We encourage light, loose clothing that covers shoulders to prevent sunburn.

Seek Shade

We use shaded areas for outdoor activities during high UV times and limit time in direct sun between 11am-3pm when possible.
