We have had a number of reports recently of pupils riding their bikes in an unsafe manner, both to and from school and in their own time. The safety of our pupils is our main concern and we would ask that you talk to your children and ensure they are aware of the dangers, to both themselves and other road users, when on their bikes

If we feel that children are not able to ride in a safe manner, we will ask them not to ride their bike to and from school.

Below are some simple tips to help keep everyone safe:

**1. Wear Your Helmet** Always wear a properly fitted helmet – it's the best way to protect your head!

### 2. Be Seen and Heard

Wear bright clothes and use bike lights or reflectors, especially in the early morning or evening. A bell or horn helps let others know you're coming.

3. Watch for Traffic Stop, look, and listen before crossing roads. Always follow traffic signals and ride in the same direction as cars.

4. Stay on the Path Use bike lanes or paths when available. Ride in a straight line and watch for pedestrians.

#### 5. Ride with care

Do not take risks which could put yourself and other road users in danger.

#### 6. Check Your Bike

Before you ride, check your brakes, tyres, and chain to make sure everything is working properly.
