

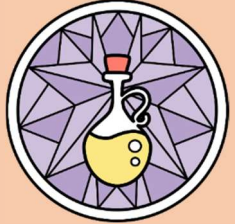
Galilee to Jerusalem

Key Vocabulary

1.	Messiah	"Anointed one" - Christians believe Jesus to be the Messiah, the prophesised one from the Old Testament.
2.	God's Kingdom	The spiritual realm where God rules as King. This is described in St Matthew's Gospel as 'The Kingdom of Heaven'.
3.	Prayer	A way in which we can speak to God for a range of purposes.
4.	Nicene Creed	A Christian statement of faith that summarises core beliefs about God, Jesus, and the Holy Spirit.
5.	Marginalised	A person or group of people that are treated like they don't matter and pushed to the edges of society.
6.	Societal attitudes	The beliefs, feelings, and behaviours that people in a society generally have about a person or group of people.
7.	Values	A person's beliefs that guide their actions, decisions and priorities.
8.	Virtues	A virtue is a good habit or trait that helps us to act according to God's love for us.

Sacraments

1.	Sacrament of Reconciliation	A sacrament where the sins we have committed since Baptism are cleansed.
		
2.	Sacrament of the Sick	A sacrament where a sick person is anointed with oil to strengthen and protect them.
		

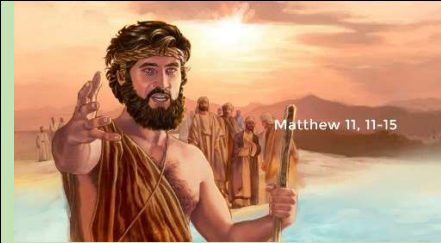
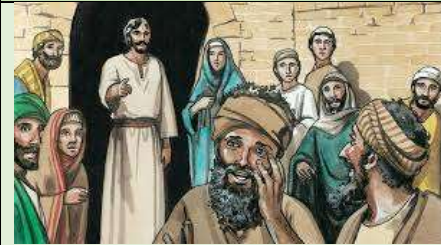
Faith in action
